

# Daisy Farm Crafts

## Crochet Magnolia Baby Blanket

### MATERIALS

Caron One Pound (100% acrylic, 454 g/16 oz, 742 m/812 yds)

1 skein Soft Gray Mix, 1 skein White

Size H/5.00mm hook, scissors, tapestry needle

4 inch pom pom maker

### SIZE

Finished size 32 in x 33 in

### STITCHES

**Half Double Crochet (HDC):** Yarn over (YO), insert your hook, YO and pull up a loop, YO and pull through three loops on hook.

### PATTERN

With Gray, CH (chain) 95.

**Row 1:** In the third chain from the hook, HDC (half double crochet) HDC in each chain space across. CH 2 and turn.

**Rows 2 - 12:** HDC in each stitch, CH 2 and turn. (However, on row 12, pull through with white on the last stitch and chain 2 with white and turn.)

**Rows 13 - 14:** HDC in each stitch with white, pull through with grey on row 14. CH 2 and turn.

**Rows 15 - 68:** Repeat rows 2-14.

To clarify, there are 12 rows of grey, separated by 2 rows of white.

Weave in all ends and make pom poms!

Here's a tip about the pom poms, wrap them a lot, make them really thick before you cut them. Also, when you add the string to pull them tight, I used 2 strands. So I squeeze it tight and tie with one, and then do it again. Leave these strings long so you can easily tie them onto the corner of your blanket. Then, I double knot them around the corner of the blankets then clip the ends to about the length of the pom pom and let it blend in.
