Crochet Textured Baby Blanket in Pink

MATERIALS

Bernat Softee Baby Chunky (100% acrylic) 7 skeins any color Size L/8.00mm hook, scissors, tapestry needle

SIZE

Finished size 36 in x 36 in


STITCHES

Single Crochet (SC): Insert your hook, yarn over (YO) and pull up a loop, YO and pull through two loops on hook.

Half Double Crochet (HDC): YO, insert your hook, YO and pull up a loop, YO and pull through three loops on hook.

Double Crochet 2 Together Cluster (DC2togCL): YO, insert your hook, YO and pull up a loop, YO and pull through 2 loops, YO, insert your hook into same space, YO and pull up a loop, YO and pull through 2 loops, YO and pull through all loops on hook.

Wide Half Double Crochet (WHDC): YO, insert your hook between stitch posts, YO and pull up a loop, YO and pull through three loops on hook.



PATTERN

Chain 72 + 2. (If you'd like to make this bigger, use a multiple of 8 times an odd number then add two.)

Row 1: In the second chain from the hook, work 1 single crochet (SC). Work 1 SC in each chain to the end of the row. (73 SC)

Rows 2 - 9: Ch 1 and turn. 1 SC in the first stitch. *DC2togCL in next st. 1 SC in next st. Repeat from * to last stitch. 1 SC in last st. CH 1 and turn.

(Tip: every row will always begin and end with a SC throughout the entire blanket. Also, clusters are worked into the top of clusters of the row below and SC worked into SC of the row below.)

Row 10: Work 1 SC in first stitch. *(DC2togCL in next stitch followed by 1 SC in next stitch) across the next 8 stitches. Work 1 HDC in each of the next 8 stitches. Repeat from * ending last 8 stitches with (DC2togCL followed by a SC.)

Rows 11 - 17: CH 1 and turn. Work 1 SC in first stitch. *(DC2togCL in next stitch followed by 1 SC in next stitch) 4 times. 1 WHDC in the next 8 spaces. Repeat from * ending the last 8 stitches with (DC2togCL followed by a SC.)

Rows 18 - 25: Repeat row 2 through 9.

Rows 26 - 33: Repeat row 10 through 17.

Repeat rows 18 - 33 two more times. Last 8 rows of blanket repeat rows 2 - 9. Final Row, work 1 SC in each stitch across, tie off and weave in the ends.

No border needed since you started and ended each row with a SC and also the first and last rows are all SC.
