Crochet Hygge Moss Blanket

MATERIALS

Red Heart Hygge (70% acrylic, 30% nylon, 141 g/5 oz, 121 m/132 yds)

6 skeins Pearl, 2 skeins Slate Blue, 1 skein Rust

Size K/6.5mm hook, tapestry needle, scissors

SIZE

Finished size 30 in x 40 in

STITCHES

Single Crochet (SC): Insert your hook, yarn over (YO) and pull up a loop, YO and pull through two loops.

PATTERN

Chain 110 (or any even number) with Pearl.

Row 1: Start in the 4th chain from the hook, and work SC, CH 1. Then skip 1 chain, and work SC, CH 1 into the next chain. Continue the sequence of skip 1, SC, CH 1, until you reach the end of the chain. On the last chain, work 1 SC and pull through with Slate Blue before you finish the stitch. Then chain 2 and turn. Cut the White, leaving about a 6 inch tail.

Note: You can either leave the tails to weave in later or you can crochet over them by wrapping them around the back of your work. I chose to wrap them around the back of my work and crochet over the tails as I went. Then when I came back to that side of the blanket again, I inserted my hook underneath the tails I had crocheted over to help keep them extra secure.

Row 2: Work 1 row of the moss stitch in Slate Blue: work the first SC underneath the chain 1 space. Then chain one, skip over the SC of the row below and work the next SC underneath the chain space. Continue the pattern of SC, CH 1 into each chain space of the row below. The last SC should be worked into the space between the CH 2 turning chain and SC from the previous row. When you reach the end of the row, pull through with Pearl. Chain 2 and turn.

Row 3: Work 1 row of the moss stitch in Pearl. At the end of the row, pull through with Slate Blue. Chain 2 and turn.

Row 4: Work 1 row of the moss stitch in Slate Blue. At the end of the row, pull through with Pearl. Chain 2 and turn.

Row 5: Work 1 row of the moss stitch in Pearl. At the end of the row, pull through with Slate Blue. Chain 2 and turn.

Row 6: Work 1 row of the moss stitch in Slate Blue. At the end of the row, pull through with Pearl. Chain 2 and turn.

Rows 7 - 9: Work 3 rows of the moss stitch in Pearl. At the end of the 10th row, pull through with Rust. Chain 2 and turn.

Row 10: Work 1 row of the moss stitch in Rust. At the end of the row, pull through with Pearl. Chain 2 and turn.

Row 11: Work 1 row of the moss stitch in Pearl. At the end of the row, pull through with Rust. Chain 2 and turn.

Row 12: Work 1 row of the moss stitch in Rust. At the end of the row, pull through with Pearl. Chain 2 and turn.

Row 13: Work 1 row of the moss stitch in Pearl. At the end of the row, pull through with Rust. Chain 2 and turn.

Row 14: Work 1 row of the moss stitch in Rust. At the end of the row, pull through with Pearl. Chain 2 and turn.

Rows 15 - 17: Work 3 rows of the moss stitch in Pearl. At the end of the 10th row, pull through with Slate Blue. Chain 2 and turn.

Repeat rows 2 through 17 one more time.

Then repeat rows 2 through 9 seven times (except at the end of row 10, you won't pull through with rust, you will only use blue in the middle section).

Then repeat rows 2 through 17 two more times and end with 3 rows of the moss stitch in Pearl.

BORDER

Weave in all ends before starting the border.

Round 1: Pull up a loop in any corner and chain 2. Work the moss stitch (SC, CH 1, SK 1) around the outside of the blanket (on the sides, insert your hook every other row). Work 3 SCs into each corner.

Round 2: When you reach the corner you started with, slip stitch into the start stitch, then chain 2 and turn. Work one more round of the moss stitch around the edge of the blanket. When you reach the corner you started with, slip stitch into the starting stitch and tie off.
