

Daisy Farm Crafts

Crochet Mint Stripes and Fringe Blanket

MATERIALS

Caron One Pound (100% acrylic, 454 g/16 oz, 742 m/812 yds)

2 skeins Pale Green, 1 skein Rose

Size H/5.00mm, tapestry needle, scissors

SIZE

Finished size 35 in x 44 in

STITCHES

Half Double Crochet (HDC): Yarn over (YO), insert your hook, YO and pull up a loop, YO and pull through three loops on hook.

Front Two Loop Half Double Crochet (F2LHDC) Cluster: YO, insert your hook up through front two loops, YO and pull up a loop, YO, insert your hook again into same space, YO and pull up a loop, YO and pull through all loops on hook.

BORDER

Weave in all ends.

Round 1: With Rose, pull up a loop in any corner and chain one. Work one round of HDC around the blanket, working 3 HDCs into each corner. When you reach the corner you started with it, slip stitch into the starting stitch, chain 1, and tie off.

Tassels: I added tassels to each end of the blanket and spaced them about 11 chains apart (give or take—doesn't need to be perfect, just look spaced apart evenly).

For the tassels, you can wrap your yarn around a notebook several times then cut it in half to make strands that are the same length, or just use measuring tape to cut several 9 to 10 inch pieces.

Take two to three pieces of yarn (or however many you want) and fold them in half. Insert the folded end into the chain space above your border row. Pull the ends through the loop...And pull tight to make a knot. And that's it! You can space them out however you wish, make them as thick or as thin as you like, and trim them to be however long you like.
