Crochet Beginner Grit Stitch Baby Blanket

MATERIALS

Red Heart Hygge Charm (97% acrylic, 3% other fibers, 198 g/7 oz, 395 meters/432 yards) 2 skeins Starlight, 1 skein Shooting Star Size I/5.5mm hook, scissors, tapestry needle

SIZE

Finished blanket 28 in x 34 in Gauge 4 in = 20 st and 17 rows of pattern

STITCH

Single Crochet (SC): Insert your hook, yarn over (YO), pull up a loop, YO, pull through two loops on hook.

PATTERN

Chain 126 with Starlight. (Pattern repeat is any even number.)

ROW 1: SC in the second chain from hook. *skip one chain, SC 2 times into the next chain. Repeat * across working only one SC into the last space. Chain one and turn.

ROW 2: SC once into the first SC. *skip next stitch, SC 2 times into the next stitch. Repeat *across. End with one SC into the last stitch. (Note, on the first row you skipped over a chain to the last space and worked your one SC, in row 2 you won't. Simply work one SC into the last space, which is the next space.) Chain one and turn.

Repeat row 2 for the remainder of the blanket.

Here's how I did my color changes: 32 rows of Starlight, 6 rows of Shooting Star, 32 rows of Starlight, 12 rows of Shooting Star, 32 rows of Starlight, 6 rows of Shooting Star, 32 rows of Starlight

BORDER

Before beginning the border, weave in the ends.

With Shooting Star, work 1 SC into each stitch per row on the sides of the blanket, and 3 SC into each corner space. Join with a slip stitch to the beginning SC.
