

Daisy Farm Crafts

Beginner Crochet Dreamy Infinity Scarf

MATERIALS

Red Heart Dreamy (250 g/8.8 oz, 426 m/466 yds)

1 skein any color

Size K/6.5mm hook, tapestry needle, scissors

SIZE

Finished size 4.5 in x 58 in

STITCHES

Half Double Crochet (HDC): Yarn over (YO), insert your hook and pull up a loop, YO, pull through all three loops on hook.

PATTERN

Chain 175 (or a chain that measures between 55 and 60 inches).

ROW 1: Starting in the 3rd chain from the hook, work 1 HDC in each chain. Chain 2 and turn.

ROW 2: Work 1 HDC in each stitch across the row, inserting your hook up through the front two loops only. (The turning chain does not count as a stitch, so your first stitch should be worked directly into the first front two loops of the row below.) Chain 2 and turn.

Repeat row 2 until your scarf measures your desired width. I worked 14 rows for a width of 4 and 1/2 inches. When you've reached your desired width, tie off and leave an extra long tail that you can use to sew the two ends of the scarf together with a tapestry needle to make it a circle. (You can also slip stitch the two ends together if you prefer.)

Be sure to keep the lines of the scarf matched up when you sew the ends together. After you sew the scarf together, turn it inside out so the seam is on the inside of the circle.
