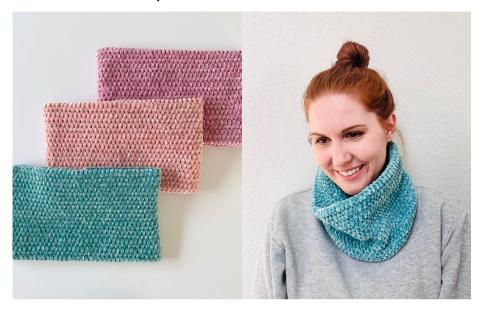
# Daisy Farm Crafts

Easy Crochet Double Velvet Cowl

# **MATERIALS**

Bernat Baby Velvet (100% polyester, 300 g/10.5 oz, 450 m/492 yds) 1 skein any color Size H/5.00mm, tapestry needle, measuring tape, scissors

# SIZE

Finished size 12 in x 7 inGauge 4 in = 13 st and 12 rows of wide DC

### STITCHES

**Double Crochet (DC):** Yarn over (YO), insert your hook, YO and pull up a loop, YO and pull through two loops, YO and pull through remaining two loops.

Wide Double Crochet (wide DC): Yarn over (YO), insert your hook between stitch posts, YO and pull up a loop, YO and pull through two loops, YO and pull through remaining two loops.

### **PATTERN**

Make a chain that measures 20 inches (I chained 80).

**ROW 1:** Starting in the 4th chain from the hook, work a DC into each chain. Chain 2 and turn.

**ROW 2:** Work a wide DC into each space between the DCs of the previous row. Chain 2 and turn.

Repeat row 2 until you have enough rows to measure appx. 14 inches.

When you finish your last row, keep crocheting and slip stitch the two ends together.

After you combine the top and bottom, tie off and leave yourself a really long tail - about 20 to 25 inches. Turn your work inside out, then with the seam facing outward, use a tapestry needle and your long tail to sew all four sides together. After you finish sewing them together, weave the tail into the scarf until its secure. Then turn your work inside out again and enjoy your super cozy cowl! xo, Hannah







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
