Crochet Winter Tree Stripe Hot Pad

MATERIALS

Lily Sugar 'n Cream The Original Yarn (100% cotton, 71 g/2.5 oz, 109 m/120 yds)

1 skein White, 1 skein Sage Green

Size H/5.0 mm hook, scissors, tapestry needle

STITCHES

Herringbone Half Double Crochet (HHDC): Yarn over (YO), insert your hook, YO, pull up a loop and pull directly through first loop on hook, YO, pull through remaining two loops.

Single Crochet (SC): Insert your hook, yarn over and pull a loop back through, yarn over and pull through two loops.

PATTERN

Chain 26 with white.

ROW 1: Starting in the 3rd chain from the hook, work one Herringbone Half Double Crochet, (HHDC) in each chain across, CH 2 and turn. (24 HHDC)

ROW 2: Work HHDC in the top of the first HHDC of the row below and HHDC in each stitch across. CH 2 and turn.

ROW 3: HHDC in each of the first 4 stitches, pull through with color on the last step of the 4th HHDC stitch, HHDC in each of the next 16 spaces carrying the white strand along and crocheting over it, pull up the white on the last step of the 16th stitch, HHDC with white in each of the last 4 spaces, CH 2 and turn.

ROW 4: HHDC in each of stitch across with white, CH 2 and turn.

ROW 5: HHDC in each of the next 5 stitches, pulling through with the new color on the last step, (carefully pull the color across the back of the work, since you will be making a back, this will not show, there is no need to cut the yarn after every row, just pull the strand across the back of the work, use this technique now and throughout.) HHDC in the next 14 stitches, HHDC in each of the last 5 stitches. Ch 2 and turn.

ROW 6: HHDC in each stitch across with white, CH 2 and turn.

ROW 7: HHDC in each of the next 6 stitches with white, HHDC the next 12 with new color, HHDC in each of the last 6 stitches. CH 2 and turn.

ROW 8: HHDC in each stitch across with white, CH 2 and turn.

ROW 9: HHDC in each of the next 7 stitches with white, HHDC the next 10 with new color, HHDC in each of the last 7 stitches. CH 2 and turn.

ROW 10: HHDC in each stitch across with white, CH 2 and turn.

ROW 11: HHDC in each of the next 8 stitches with white, HHDC the next 8 with new color, HHDC in each of the last 8 stitches. CH 2 and turn.

ROW 12: HHDC in each stitch across with white. CH 2 and turn.

ROW 13: HHDC in each of the next 9 stitches with white, HHDC the next 6 with new color, HHDC in each of the last 9 stitches, CH 2 and turn.

ROW 14: HHDC in each stitch across with white, CH 2 and turn.

ROW 15: HHDC in each of the next 10 stitches with white, HHDC the next 4 with new color, HHDC in each of the last 10 stitches, CH 2 and turn.

ROW 16: HHDC in each stitch across with white, CH 2 and turn.

ROW 17: HHDC in each of the next 11 stitches with white, HHDC the next 2 with new color, HHDC in the each of the last 11 stitches, CH 2 and turn.

ROWS 18 and 19: HHDC in each stitch across with white, CH 2 and turn. Tie off.

Make the back of the hot pad by starting with 26 chains in any color, work the first 9 rows, using the above HHDC stitch in one color, then the final 10 rows in the second color. Tie off.

With the right side facing out, use a single crochet stitch to crochet the two together, pulling up your first loop into any corner working 3 SC into each corner and one SC per row. When you return to the starting corner, slip stitch to join, then chain 12, work SC in each CH back down toward the hot pad, slip stitch to the starting CH to form a loop. Tie off and weave in all ends to secure. Enjoy your hot pad!
