Crochet Ribbed Velvet Twist Headband

MATERIALS

Bernat Baby Velvet (100% polyester, 300 g/10.5 oz, 450 m/492 yds) 1 large skein any color makes at least 2 headbands Size H/5.00mm hook, tapestry needle, scissors

SIZE

AVERAGE HEAD CIRCUMFERENCE

Preemie 12-13 inches Newborn-3 Months 13-14 inches 3-6 Months 14-15 inches 6-12 Months 15.5-16.5 inches 12-24 Months 16-18 inches Child (3-10 years) 19-21 inches Teen/Small Adult 21 inches Medium Adult 22 inches Large Adult 23 inches

STITCHES

Double Crochet (DC): Yarn over (YO), insert your hook, YO and pull up a loop, YO, pull through two loops, YO, pull through remaining two loops.

Front and Back Post Double Crochet (FPDC & BPDC): A front post DC means you insert your hook from front to back around the post of the next DC and work your DC. A back post DC means you insert your hook from the back to the front and work a DC.

PATTERN

Chain 20 for adults, 18 for kids, or 16 for babies.

ROW 1: Starting in the 4th chain from the hook, work a DC in each chain. CH 2 and turn.

ROW 2: The chain 2 counts as the first stitch. Around the next stitch, work a FPDC. Around the next stitch, work a BPDC. Continue alternating FPDC and BPDC to the end of the row. When you reach the end of the row, work a regular DC underneath the turning chain. CH 2 and turn.

ROW 3: The chain 2 counts as the first stitch. Continue alternating BPDC and FPDC to the end of the row, always matching the direction you work around the post so that it pops out the same direction as the previous row. When you reach the end of the row, work a regular DC underneath the turning chain. CH 2 and turn.

Repeat rows 2 through 3 until headband measures 3 inches less than head circumference.

For the twist:

Step 1: Lay the band out and fold in half and slide one side of the band across so one end is matched up to the middle of the other.

Step 2: Fold the right hand side around the back.

Step 3: Fold the left hand side around the front, giving you four layers

Step 4: Sew with the tapestry needle through all four layers. Tie off and knot your ends together.

Turn the headband so the seam is on the inside of the headband and you have a twist.
