Crochet Striped Heart Hot Pad

MATERIALS

Lily Sugar'n Cream The Original Yarn (100% cotton, 71 g/ 2.5 oz, 109 m/120 yds)

1 skein Tea Rose, 1 skein Cotton White

Size H/5.00mm hook, scissors, tapestry needle

Heart Graph (see below)

SIZE

Finished size 10 in x 10 in

Gauge 4 in = 14 st and 12 rows of HHDC

STITCHES

Herringbone Half Double Crochet (HHDC): Yarn over (YO), insert your hook, YO and pull a loop back through and continue pulling back through the first loop on your hook. YO and pull through the remaining two loops on your hook.

Half Double Crochet (HDC): YO, insert your hook, YO and pull up a loop, YO and pull through all three loops on your hook.

HDC Puff: YO, insert your hook, (in this pattern you will insert your hook around the post of HDC stitch you just made) YO and pull and loop up, repeat from * 2 more times. YO and pull through all loops on your hook.

PATTERN

Print the graph. The odd rows are read right to left, the even rows left to right.

Chain 27 with White.

Row 1: Work 1 HHDC in the third chain from the hook. Work 1 HHDC in each chain across the row. Chain 2 and turn. (25 HHDC)

Tip: Turning chains do not count as stitches.

Row 2: (right side, keep all the ends to the wrong side of the work.) Work 1 HHDC in each of the next 12 sts. Change color, work 1 HHDC, change color, 1 HHDC in each of the remaining 12 sts. CH 2 and turn.

Row 3: HHDC in each of the next 11 sts. Change color, work HHDC in each of the next 3 sts. Change color, HHDC in remaining 11 sts. CH 2 and turn.

Row 4: HHDC in each stitch across the row. CH 2 and turn.

Rows 5 - 21: Follow the graph making the color changes as needed.

Tip: Do not cut the yarn, leave the tail to the wrong side of the work and pull through when needed.

Before tying off, work one round of single crochet. Work 3 SC into each corner space, work 2 SC per the end of a row, skip a row, work 2 SC per stitch, skip a stitch. Join with a slip stitch to the starting SC, tie off.

Make a solid color backing using the pattern above, omitting color changes.

Finish off with one round of single crochet as explained above.

BORDER

Place the two squares together with the wrong side facing in. Join the two squares in any corner with a slip stitch then work single crochet into each single crochet around. Join with a slip stitch to the first stitch, CH 2 and turn.
