

# Daisy Farm Crafts

## Crochet Bunny Hot Pad/Pot Holder

### MATERIALS

*for one hot pad*

Bernat Handicrafter Cotton (100% cotton, 50 g/1.75 oz, 73 m/80 yds)

1 skein White, 1 skein Robins Egg

Size H/5.00mm hook, tapestry needle, scissors

Graph (see below)

### SIZE

Finished size 8 in x 8 in

### STITCHES

**Single Crochet (SC):** Insert your hook, yarn over (YO) and pull up a loop, YO and pull through two loops.

### PATTERN

Chain 27 in white.

Following the graph from right to left on the odd-numbered rows, and left to right on the even-number rows. Each square represents 1 SC. Work SC into each chain, making the appropriate color changes.

To change colors, pull through with new color on last step of the previous stitch. No need to cut the white, or carry along the row since all ends will be hidden in the middle of the hot pad.

Always chain 1 and turn at the end of each row.

When finished with the graph, work one complete round of SC into each stitch, and at the end of each row, and work 3 SC into each corner. Join with a slip stitch to the first SC of the round, tie off.

Make a second side in a solid color.

Joining the two sides with a round of SC. Matching the hot pad together, work SC into each stitch inserting your hook through both pads to join them together. Work 3 SC into each corner. Join to the starting SC and ch 2.

Continue in the same direction, begin the round with 2 DC into the space where you joined the round. \*SK two stitches, work 1 SC into the next stitch. SK 2 sts, 5 DC into the next st. Repeat from \* around. (On the corners, skip only one stitch if needed.) At the end of the round, estimate if you need to skip one or two stitches in between the shells and SC. Finish the round with 2 DC into the starting ch 2 space. Slip stitch into the top of the ch 2 to join, tie off and weave in the ends.
