MATERIALS

Caron Simply Soft (100% acrylic, 170 g/6 oz, 288 m/315 yds)

1 skein each White, Dark Country Blue, Grey Heather

Size H/5.00mm hook, tapestry needle, scissors

SIZE

Finished size 8 in x 89 in

Gauge 2 in = 8 st and 7 rows of WHDC

STITCHES

Half Double Crochet (HDC): Yarn over (YO), insert your hook, YO and pull up a loop, YO and pull through three loops.

Wide Half Double Crochet (WHDC): YO, insert your hook in between stitch posts, YO and pull up a loop, YO and pull through three loops.

Double Crochet (DC): YO, insert your hook, YO and pull up a loop, YO and pull through two loops, YO and pull through remaining two loops.

Front and Back Post Double Crochet (FPDC & BPDC): A front post double crochet means you insert your hook from front to back around the post of the next DC and work a DC. A back post double crochet means you insert your hook from back to front around the post of the next DC and work a DC.

PATTERN

Chain 32 (or any number to measure approximately 8 inches).

ROW 1: In the 3rd chain from the hook, work 1 Half Double Crochet (HDC). HDC in each chain space across the row. (30)

ROW 2: Chain 2 and turn. In the first space just to the left of the post and underneath all three loops a HDC makes, work 1 wide half double crochet (WHDC.) WHDC into each stitch across the row, the last WHDC will be worked in between the last post and the turning chain.

ROWS 3 - to the end: As row 2.

Pull through with new colors in this order: 18 Rows White, 9 Blue, 5 Grey, 9 Blue, 2 White, 2 Grey, 2 White, 2 Grey, 2 White, 2 Grey, 2 White, 9 Blue, 5 Grey, 9 Blue. Repeat these color changes three times, then end with 18 rows of White.

RIBBED BORDER

ROW 1: After the last section of white, Chain 3 and turn. Work 1 Double Crochet (DC) into each stitch across the row.

ROW 2: CH 3 and turn. *Work 2 FPDC around each of the next 2 DC. 2 BPDC around each of the next 2 DC. Repeat from * to the end of the row. Work last DC underneath and around the turning chain. CH 3 and turn.

ROWS 3 and 4: As Row 2 making sure you are working the post stitches toward the direction as the row below. You want to create lines on the same side of the work as the row below. Tie off and weave in all the ends.
