Crochet Wildflower Blanket

MATERIALS

Bernat Softee Cotton (60% cotton, 40% acrylic, 120g / 4.2 oz, 232 meters / 254 yards, 3 weight)

4 skeins of Golden (or any color)

Size G, H, I, or J hook. (You'll need to find the correct tension for you)

Scissors, tapestry needle

SIZE

28 x 28 inches

Gauge: 8 sc3tog plus ch 1 sts and 7 rows = 4 inches.

This stitch needs to be loosely done. A practice swatch can help you determine what is the appropriate hook size to use. I made the base chain with a size G 4.00 mm hook and then used an I 5.5 mm size hook for the trinity stitch.

STITCHES

Single Crochet: Insert your hook, YO and pull up a loop, YO and pull through two loops on hook.

Single Crochet 3 together (SC3TOG): Insert your hook into the designated stitch, yarn over and pull a loop back through, insert your hook into the next stitch, yarn over and pull up a loop, insert your hook into the next stitch, yarn over and pull a loop. Yarn over and pull through all loops on your hook.

PATTERN

Chain 110 (or any even number if you'd like to make it larger)

Row 1: Begin in the second chain from the hook and work 1 SC. Insert hook into same space as SC just worked and pull up a loop (first leg of st). Insert hook into next chain and pull up a loop, (second leg of st) insert hook into next chain and pull up a loop (third leg of st). Yarn over and pull through all loops on hook. (SC3TOG complete) CHAIN 1.

*Insert hook into the same chain as third leg of st, and pull up a loop. Insert hook into the next chain and pull up a loop, insert hook into the next chain and pull up a loop, yarn over and pull through all loops on hook. CHAIN 1.

Repeat from * across the row until there are 2 chains left. Work 1 more SC3TOG, OMIT the CH 1. SC into the final stitch where you worked the 3rd leg. CH 1 and turn.

Row 2: SC into the first stitch. Beginning in the same space as the SC just worked, insert hook and pull up a loop, insert hook into next st and pull up a loop, insert hook into next st and pull up a loop, yarn over and pull through all loops. CH 1.

*SC3TOG always beginning the first leg in the same space as the third leg of the stitch previous. CH 1.

Repeat from * across the row. Omit the final CH 1, SC into the final st where you worked the 3rd leg, CH 1 and turn.

Row 3 until the blanket is the height needed: Repeat row 2.

BORDER

First Round: After completing the last row, CH 1 and turn. SC into the first stitch. Work 2 SC into the next st, *skip the next st, 2 SC into the next st. Repeat from * across the row.

Work 3 SC into each corner.

Work 2 SC every other row on the sides of the blanket.

Do not join the rounds, do not turn.

Second through Fourth Rounds: Work 1 SC into each SC and 3 SC into each corner SC. Do not join or turn the rounds.

(Tip, in order to achieve a cross stitch look of the single crochets, Hook Over the yarn and pull through. See video tutorial for a demonstration.)

Fifth Round: SC into the first SC, *CH 3. SC into the same space as SC previously worked. SC into each of the next 4 sts. Repeat from * around entire blanket, join with a slip stitch and tie off.
