

Daisy Farm Crafts

Crochet Lake House Throw



Pattern by Sugar Joye

MATERIALS

Red Heart Super Saver Jumbo (100% acrylic, 396 g/14 oz, 681 meters/744 yards, 4 weight worsted)
1 skein Aran

Red Heart Super Saver (100% acrylic, 198 g/7 oz, 333 meters/364 yards, 4 weight worsted)
1 skein each; Black, Light Grey, Grey Heather, Charcoal

Caron One Pound (100% acrylic, 454g / 16 oz, 742 meters / 812 yards, 4 weight worsted)
1 skein Azure

7mm Crochet hook, tapestry needle, measuring tape

SIZE

Approximate finished size 60 in x 48 in

STITCHES

Single Crochet (SC): Insert your hook, yarn over (YO) and pull up a loop, YO and pull through two loops.

Half Double Slip Stitch: YO, insert your hook, YO, pull up a loop and pull directly through two loops on hook.

PATTERN

Chain 140 (or any even number needed for approximately 6 feet.)

ROW 1: Starting in the 4th chain from hook, work 1 Single Crochet (SC), *chain 1, skip next chain, SC in next. Repeat from * across until the end of the row. Chain 28 (for fringe) and turn.

ROW 2: Begin in the second chain from the hook, work 1 HDSS into each of the next 27 sts. *CH 1, skip SC, SC into the ch 1 space. Repeat from * across the row. Work final SC in between the last SC and the turning chains. CH 28 and turn.

ROW 3: Begin in the second chain from the hook, work 1 HDSS into each of the next 27 sts. CH 1, skip SC, SC into the ch 1 space. Repeat from * across the row, making sure the last SC is worked around the CH 1 before the fringe. CH 2 and turn.

ROW 4: Starting in the first CH 1 space from previous row, work 1 SC. *CH 1, skip 1 SC, SC in next CH 1 space, repeat from * across the row, ending with 1 SC worked into the space between the final SC and CH 2 turning chain from the previous row. CH 2 and turn.

Row 5: Repeat row 4.

Going forward, the fringe rows are worked with 2 rows of regular moss stitch in between. For a more full fringe look, work them every row.

Follow the color change chart for 142 rows.

TIP: to change colors, work the SL ST's of the fringe first, pull through with new color on the last SL ST, CH 1 with new color and begin Moss Stitch.

Tie off by pulling last loop through and weave in the ends. For a little flair, I also tied a knot at the top of each fringe piece.
