

Daisy Farm Crafts

Crochet Clarissa Scarf



MATERIALS

Red Heart Super Saver (4 weight, 100% acrylic, 198 g/7 oz, 333 meters/364 yards)

1 skein each- Aran, Cornmeal, Buff, Carrot, Light Gray

9.0 mm hook

Scissors, tapestry needle

SIZE

Approximately 6 ft x 6 inches wide.

STITCHES

Single Crochet (SC): Insert your hook, YO and pull up a loop, YO and pull through two loops on hook.

Berry Stitch (BS): YO, insert hook, YO and pull up a loop, YO, pull through one loop on hook, YO, insert hook, YO and pull up a loop, YO, pull through all five loops on hook.

PATTERN

Chain 130 with Cornmeal. (Or, if using different yarn or hook size, chain any even number for approximately 6ft.)

ROW 1: Begin in the second chain from the hook with SC. SC into each chain across the row. On the last step of the last stitch of the row, pull through with Buff. Cut Cornmeal. CH 1 and turn.

(Going forward, the pattern will just say change color at the end of the row, but you still will pull through with new color on the last step of the last stitch of the row. Also, cut each color after use.)

ROW 2: SC into each SC across the row. Change color to Aran. CH 1 and turn.

ROW 3 and 4: SC into each SC across the row. Change color to Light Gray. CH 1 and turn.

ROW 5 and 6: SC into each SC across the row. Change color to Aran. CH 1 and turn.

ROW 7 - 14: SC into the first st, *BS into the next st. SC into the next st. Repeat from * across the row. At the end of the 14th row, change color to Carrot. CH 1 and turn.

(Tip: rows 7 - 14 should begin and end with a SC.)

ROW 15 and 16: SC into each st. across the row. Change color to Buff. CH 1 and turn.

ROW 17: SC into each st. across the row. Tie off.

Weave in all the ends before beginning the fringe.

Fringe

Begin on the short end of the scarf with Buff.

ROW 1: Pull up a loop in the corner, CH 1 and SC into that same st. SC at the end of each row across the edge. CH 1 and turn.

ROW 2: SL ST into the first st. *CH 15. Begin in the second chain with SL ST and work 1 SL ST into each chain back to the edge of the scarf. SL ST to the next SC st on the edge of the scarf. Repeat from * across the row.

(Keep the slip stitches very loose, consider using a larger hook if they are curling on you or you are finding it hard to work into the chain.)

After last fringe, tie off and weave in the end.

Work fringe on the other end of the scarf with same instructions.
