

Daisy Farm Crafts

Beginner Crochet Color Block Infinity Scarf



MATERIALS

Patons Canadiana (100% acrylic, 100 g/3.5 oz, 187 m/205 yds)

1 skein each White, Fool's Gold, Pale Gray Mix, Teal Heather

Size J/6.00mm hook, scissors, tapestry needle

SIZE

Finished size 8 in x 80 in

Gauge 4 in = 12 st and 10 rows

STITCHES

Single Crochet (SC): Insert your hook, yarn over (YO) and pull up a loop, YO and pull through two loops on hook.

Double Crochet (DC): YO, insert your hook, YO and pull up a loop, YO and pull through two loops, YO and pull through remaining two loops on hook.

PATTERN

Chain 35 (or any odd number) with Teal Heather.

Row 1: Starting in the 2nd chain from the hook, work 1 SC. In the next stitch, work 1 DC. Alternate working SC and DC in each stitch across the row, ending with a DC in the last chain. CH 1 and turn.

Row 2: SC into the top of the DC you just made in the row below. Then, DC into the next SC. Alternate the DC and SC across the whole row. Always work a DC into the top of a SC, and work a SC into the top of the DC. CH 1 and turn.

Repeat row 2 for the remainder of the scarf with the following color changes:

24 rows Teal Heather, 22 rows White, 10 rows Pale Gray Mix, 6 rows White, 5 rows Pale Gray Mix, 24 rows Fool's Gold, 24 rows Teal Heather, 24 rows White, 24 rows Pale Gray Mix, 24 Fool's Gold

To change colors, work the last DC of the row until the last step of the stitch when you have two loops left on your hook. Pull through the two loops with the new color and leave a tail that you can weave into the scarf later. Cut off the previous color leaving another tail you can weave in later.

When finished, tie off and leave yourself a long tail you can use to sew the two ends of the scarf together. (You can also slip stitch the two ends together before tying off if you prefer.) Then weave in any remaining ends with a tapestry needle and enjoy your scarf!
