

# Daisy Farm Crafts

## Crochet Three Color Granny Stripe Celebration Blanket



### MATERIALS

Caron Simply Soft (170 g / 6 oz, 288 meters / 315 yards, 100% acrylic)

1 skein each Black, Harvest Red, 2 skeins White

Size H 5.0mm hook, scissors, tapestry needle, measuring tape

### SIZE

Approximately 30 x 30 inches

Gauge: 4 inches= 5 rows of grannies and 5 sets of grannies

### STITCHES

**Single Crochet (SC):** Insert your hook, YO and pull up a loop, YO and pull through two loops on hook.

**Double Crochet (DC):** YO, insert your hook, YO and pull up a loop, YO and pull through two loops, YO and pull through remaining two loops.

## **PATTERN**

Chain 101 (or any multiple of 3 plus 2 to the width you'd like)

**Pattern note:** To change color at the end of the row, pull through on the last step of the stitch with the new color. Do not cut the old color. Pick up the next color from the previous row and carry the yarn up the side of the blanket.

**ROW 1:** Begin in the second chain from the hook with SC. SC into each chain across the row. CH 3 and turn.

**ROW 2:** CH 3 counts as first DC. DC into the first stitch (st) of the previous row. \*Skip (SK) 2 sts, 3 DC into next st. Repeat from \* across the row. Work 2 DC into last st. of the row. Change color. CH 3 and turn.

**ROW 3:** Skip over the last 2 DC of previous row and work \*3 DC in the space between the next group of DC. Repeat from \* across the row. Work 1 DC into the top of the turning chain. Change color. CH 3 and turn.

**ROW 4:** DC into the first st of the previous row. \*SK over group of 3 DC. 3 DC in the space between the next group of DC. Repeat from \* across the row. Work 2 DC into the top of the turning ch. Change color. CH 3 and turn.

Repeat rows 3 and 4 until you have the height needed for size.

## **Border**

Finish the last row with the same color as ROW 1. CH 1 and turn.

Cut the other two colors and weave in the ends.

**Round 1:** Work SC into each stitch across the row. Work [SC, CH 1, SC] into each corner, work 2 SC at the end of each row on the sides. Join with a slip stitch to the first SC after working the last corner st. CH 1 and turn.

**Round 2:** Work SC into each stitch around, work [SC, CH 1, SC] around the chain 1 space of the previous round corner. Join with a SL ST to the starting SC, CH 1 and turn.

Repeat Round 2 until you have the width of the border you desire.
