Daisy Farm Crafts

Crochet Patchouli Rose Scarf





MATERIALS

Bernat Forever Fleece Yarn (100% polyester, 280 g/9.9 oz, 177 m/194 yds)

1 skein each Patchouli, Rose Hip

Size N/10 mm hook or size needed for gauge

Scissors, tapestry needle

SIZE

Finished size: 8 inches x 108 inches

Gauge: 4 inches = 7 sts and 6 rows of griddle stitch

STITCHES

Single Crochet (SC): Insert your hook, YO and pull up a loop, YO and pull through two loops on hook.

Double Crochet (DC): YO, insert your hook, YO and pull up a loop, YO and pull through two loops, YO and pull through remaining two loops.

Front Post Double Crochet (FPDC): YO and insert hook from front to back and back to front around the post from the previous row, then complete the DC. (The post pops forward)

Back Post Double Crochet (BPDC): YO, insert hook from back to front and front to back around the post from the previous row, then complete the DC. (Post pops to the back)

PATTERN

With Rose Hip, chain 15.

ROW 1: Starting in the 2nd chain from the hook, *work 1 SC. In the next stitch, work 1 DC. Repeat from * across the row. The last stitch made will be a DC. CH 1 and turn.

ROW 2: Starting in the first stitch, *work 1 SC into the top of the DC of the previous row. 1 DC into the top of the next SC. Repeat from * across the row. The last stitch will be a DC. (Always DC into SC. Always SC into DC.) CH 1 and turn.

ROWS 3-8: Repeat row 2 instructions. On the final step of the stitch in row 8, pull through with Patchouli, cut Rose Hip leaving about a 6 inch tail to weave in later.

Work the next 8 rows in Patchouli using row 2 instructions. Continue changing colors every 8 rows until you have 15 stripes. Your last stripe should be made with Rose Hip.

After working the last row of the scarf in griddle stitch with Rose Hip. CH 2 and turn.

Ribbing Section

ROW 1: Work 1 DC into each stitch across the row. CH 2 and turn.

ROW 2: Starting with the 2nd post, *work 1 DC around the post by YO and inserting hook from front to back and back to front then complete the DC. (The post pops forward: Front Post DC (FPDC.) Work 1 DC around next post by YO, inserting hook from back to front and front to back then complete the DC.

(Post pops to the back: Back Post DC (BPDC.) Repeat from * across the row, ending with the last DC worked around the turning chain. CH 2 and turn.

ROW 3: Work FPDC around FPDC of previous row and BPDC around BPDC of previous row. Work final DC around turning chain. CH 2 and turn.

ROW 4-11: Repeat row 3 instructions.

Tie off. Pull up a loop on the other end of the scarf, CH 2 and repeat the Ribbing Section rows.

Tie off and weave in all ends.
