Adventure Sweater Daisy Farm Crafts

Sizes 3 (6, 9, 12, 18, 24) month; **3** [4, 5, 6, 8] [10, 12, 14, 16] child; XS (S, M, L, XL) (2X, 3X, 4X, 5X) adult

MATERIALS Red Heart Super Saver (100% acrylic, 198 g/7 oz, 333 meters/364 yards, 4 weight, worsted) *2 (2, 2, 2, 2, 2); 2 [3, 3, 3, 4] [4, 5, 5, 5]; 5 (6, 6, 7, 7) (8, 8, 9, 9) skeins Aran, 1 skein each Paddy Green, Cherry Red, Saffron and Black Size H/5.00mm hook, tapestry needle, scissors 4 (4, 4, 4, 4, 4); 4 [4, 4, 4, 5] [5, 5, 5, 5]; 5 (5, 5, 5, 5) (5, 5, 5, 5) elongated 1.5 inch buttons Tape measure, stitch markers Optional

*Yarn amounts are estimated based on 2 skeins for sizes 18 month/ 2T

Chain 38 (40, 42, 42, 44, 44); 46 [46, 48, 48, 50] [52, 54, 54, 56]; 54 (56, 62, 64, 68) (74, 78, 80, 84)

Hhdc in 3rd chain and across. 36 (38, 40, 40, 42, 42); 44 [44, 46, 46, 48] [50, 52, 52, 54]; 52 (54, 60, 62, 66) (72, 76, 78, 82) stitches

Place the first marker in stitch 7 (7, 8, 8, 8, 8); 8 [8, 8, 8, 9] [9, 9, 9, 10]; 9 (10, 12, 13) (14, 15, 15, 16);

The second marker in stitch 12 (13, 13, 14, 14); 15 [15, 16, 16, 16] [17, 18, 18, 18]; 18 (18, 19, 20, 21) (23, 24, 25, 26); The third marker in stitch 25 (26, 28, 28, 29, 29); 30 [30, 31, 31, 33] [34, 35, 35, 37]; 35 (37, 42, 43, 46) (50, 53, 54, 57); and the fourth marker in stitch 30 (32, 33, 33, 35, 35); 37 [37, 39, 39, 40]

and the fourth marker in stitch 30 (32, 33, 33, 35, 35); **37** [**37**, **39**, **39**, **40**] [**42**, **44**, **45**]; **44** (**45**, **49**, **51**, **54**) (**59**, **62**, **64**, **67**)

ROW 2: Work 1 HHDC in each st to the marked st. In each marked st, work "HHDC, CH 2, HHDC." CH 1 and turn at the end of the row.

ROW 3: Work 1 HHDC in each st to the ch 2 space. In each ch 2 space work "HHDC, CH 2, HHDC." CH 1 and turn at the end of the row.

REPEAT ROW 3 to Row 9 (10, 10, 11, 12, 13); 13 [14, 15, 16, 17] [18, 19, 19, 20]; 19 (21, 21, 23, 23) (25, 27, 29, 31); CH 1 and turn after each row.

JOINING FOR ARMHOLES: (This will be row 10 (11, 11, 12, 13, 14); 14 [15, 16, 17, 18] [19, 20, 20, 21]; 20 (22, 22, 24, 24) (26, 28, 30, 32);) *Work HHDC in each st to the ch 2 space, work 1 HHDC into the chain 2 space, chain 2 (2, 2, 2, 2, 2); 2 [2, 3, 3, 3] [3, 4, 5, 5]; 4 (4, 4, 6, 10) (10, 10, 12, 12), skip over all stitches to the next ch 2 space, work 1 HHDC into the chain 2 sp. Repeat from * to make the next armhole. Work HHDC in each st to the end of the row, CH 1 and turn.

ROW 11 (12, 12, 13, 14, 15); 15 [16, 17, 18, 19] [20, 21, 21, 22]; 21 (23, 23, 25, 25) (27, 29, 31, 33): Work 1 HHDC in each st and work 2 (2, 2, 2, 2); 2 [2, 3, 3, 3] [3, 4, 5, 5]; 4 (4, 4, 6, 10) (10, 10, 12, 12) HHDC around the ch space that makes the armhole. CH 1 and turn.

ROW 12 (13, 13, 14, 15, 16); 16 [17, 18, 19, 20] [21, 22, 22, 23]; 22 (24, 26, 26) (28, 30, 32, 34): Work 1 HHDC in each st, pull through with Paddy Green in last step of last st. CH 1 and turn. (Don't cut Aran)

BODY OF SWEATER: Work 2 (2, 2, 2, 2, 2); 2 [2, 2, 2, 3] [3, 3, 4, 4]; 4 (4, 4, 4, 4) (4, 3, 3, 3) rows in **green**, 2 (2, 2, 2, 2, 2); 2 [2, 2, 2, 3] [3, 3, 4, 4]; 4 (4, 4, 4, 4) (4, 3, 3, 3) rows in **aran**, 2 (2, 2, 2, 2, 2); 2 [2, 2, 2, 3] [3, 3, 4, 4]; 4 (4, 4, 4, 4) (4, 3, 3, 3) rows in **red**, 2 (2, 2, 2, 2, 2); 2 [2, 2, 2, 3] [3, 3, 4, 4]; 4 (4, 4, 4, 4) (4, 3, 3, 3) rows in **aran**, 2 (2, 2, 2, 2, 2); 2 [2, 2, 2, 3] [3, 3, 4, 4]; 4 (4, 4, 4, 4) (4, 3, 3, 3) rows in **saffron**, 2 (2, 2, 2, 2); 2 [2, 2, 2, 3] [3, 3, 4, 4]; 4 (4, 4, 4, 4) (4, 3, 3, 3) rows **aran**, 2 (2, 2, 2, 2); 2 [2, 2, 2, 3] [3, 3, 4, 4]; 4 (4, 4, 4, 4) (4, 3, 3, 3) rows **black**, 1 (1, 1, 1, 1); 1 [1, 2, 2, 1] [2, 3, 1, 1]; 2 (2, 2, 1, 2) (1, 3, 3, 2) rows in **aran**. Always CH 1 and turn, cutting the color after each use and pulling aran up along the edge of the row when needed.

CH 2 and turn after finishing the last row of aran to begin the bottom edge ribbing.

For the Ribbing I would suggest "3 to 7 rows depending on your preference"

SLEEVES ROUND 1: Pull up a loop with Aran, in between the 2 (2, 2, 2, 2); 2 [2, 3, 3, 3] [3, 4, 5, 5]; 4 (4, 4, 6, 10) (10, 10, 12, 12), sts in the ch

space of the armhole. CH 1 and HHDC in that same sp. HHDC in each st to the last st of the underarm ch, Work Herringbone 2 together (HHDC2tog) in the last st and around the side (post) of next stitch. HHDC into each stitch around. HHDC2tog the side (post) of last st and the first st of the underarm. HHDC in remaining underarm stitches next to starting stitch, join with a slip st to starting st. CH 2 and turn.

SLEEVES ROUND 2: Turning chain counts as first st. Work HHDC into the next st and each st around, join with a sl st to starting chain. CH 2 and turn.

While working the instructions below, you will decrease 2 stitches every x (x, x, x, x); x [21, 9, 9, 10] [9, 8, 7, 8]; 13 (9, 11, 7, 5) (4, 4, 3, 3), rows as follows: CH 1, HHDC2tog over next 2 sts, HHDC in each stitch around until 3 stitches remain. HHDC2tog over next 2 sts, HHDC in last st, join with a sl st to starting chain. CH 2 and turn.

Work the decrease rows a total of x (x, x, x, x, x); x [2, 5, 5, 5] [6, 7, 8, 8]; 5 (7, 6, 9, 12) (14, 17, 20, 21) times until stitch count is (22 (25, 24, 26, 29, 31); 32 [30, 28, 30, 31] [32, 34, 33, 34]; 38 (37, 38, 39, 37) (38, 36, 37, 39) sts)

Work 2 (3, 5, 7, 8, 8); 14 [15, 16, 18, 14] [15, 16, 14, 16]; 20 (18, 18, 18, 18) (16, 22, 20, 18), total rows in Aran. When it's time to change color, pull through with color on the sl st, CH 2 and turn. Keep ends to the inside of the sleeve.

Repeat rounds according to color changes in body of sweater.

WRIST: *Work 1 DC into each of the next 4 (4, 5, 5, 4, 4); 4 [5, 6, 4, 5] [7, 7, 5, 7]; 5 (4, 8, 6, 11) (8, 5, 6, 6) sts, skip 1 st, repeat from * until 4 (5, 4, 4, 5, 7); 8 [6, 4, 6, 5] [4, 4, 5, 4]; 6 (7, 4, 5, 3) (4, 6, 5, 5) sts have been decreased, HHDC remaining 2 (x, x, 2, 4, 3); x [x, x, x, 1] [x, 2, 3, 2]; 2 (2, 2, 4, 1) (2, x, 2, 4) sts. Join with a slip st to first st. CH 2 and turn. (18 (20, 20, 22, 24, 24); 24 [24, 24, 24, 26] [28, 30, 28, 30]; 32 (30, 34, 34, 34) (34, 30, 32, 34) sts)

Work alternating front and back post DC for the same number of rows as the bottom of the sweater, or to desired length. Tie off.

HOOD ROW 1: Pull up a loop with aran in neck corner. CH 1 and HHDC into that same sp. Work 1 HHDC in each sp around to the other next corner. CH 1 and turn.

HOOD ROW 2: Work 1 HHDC in each stitch, CH 1 and turn.

Repeat row 2 for 15 (16, 18, 18, 19, 20); 20 [20, 21, 21, 22] [22, 22, 24, 24]; 25 (25, 25, 25, 25) (25, 25, 25) total rows.

FRONT PLACKET AND HOOD RIBBING: Pull up a loop in bottom corner. CH 2. Work 2 DC per row of DC, work 3 DC per each 2 rows of HHDC all the way up the side around the hood edge and back to the other bottom corner. CH 2 and turn. Work the same number of rows of alternating front and back post DC as the bottom hem, or to desired width. End with 1 round of single crochet in each st if desired.
